

- ** Other category includes include visitors, USC Language Academy students, and students engaged in Optional Practical Training (OPT).
- Visitors are enrolled students not in degree programs. Visitors consist of 72 and 82 Undergraduate Visitor (UV) and 95 and 101 Graduate Visitor (GV) students for Fall 2006 and Fall 2007, respectively.
- **** Optional Practical Training (OPT) is the category of graduates on F-1 (student) visas who are legally employable for 12 months following graduation. They remain under USC auspices for immigration status purposes.





Chart 4.1 Fall 2007 Gender Composition for Total International Students







Chart 5.1 Total of International Students as a Proportion of Student Enrollment







Table 5.3 15 Years of International Student Enrollment (Fall 1993-Fall 2007)



Chart 6.1 Top Ten Places of Origin of All International Students




